For the youngest readers and writers. We will work on building basic language arts skills and encourage a love of reading and writing!

3rd and 4th grades

Tuesdays 4:30 PM-5:30 PM

For the intermediate readers and writers. This class will place a special emphasis on preparing students for the 4th-grade STAAR Writing test.

5th and 6th grades

Tuesdays 5:30 PM-6:30 PM

For the advanced readers and writers. This class will focus on analysis, vocabulary building, making inferences, and digging deeper into the text for meaning. The students will be challenged to write longer, more detailed, and complex stories. We will also work on gathering information from sources and the research writing process.
